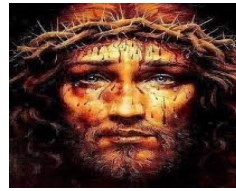

WHY IT IS CALLED "HOLY WEEK"... AND NOT JUST "THE LAST WEEK OF JESUS"

Many people say: "It's the week before Easter." But the Church does not call it that. She calls it:

HOLY WEEK

That word is not decoration. It is a judgment on the entire week. Because something happens in these days that has never happened before...and will never happen again.

"HOLY" DOES NOT MEAN CALM... IT MEANS SET APART FOR GOD

In Scripture, "holy" does not mean peaceful or gentle. It means: Set apart Consecrated belonging entirely to God So when the Church says "Holy Week," she is saying: "These days do not belong to ordinary history." "These days belong completely to God's saving action. "This is not just a week you remember. It is a week that redefines reality itself.

THIS IS THE WEEK WHERE EVERYTHING CHANGES

Look closely at what happens: A King enters... and is rejected. A disciple eats... and betrays Bread becomes Flesh... for the first time God is arrested... by His own creation Innocence is condemned... by the guilty The Creator is nailed... to His creation Death meets Life... and loses This is not normal time. This is holy time

THE HOLINESS COMES FROM WHAT CHRIST DOES

This week is holy, not because of human actions...but because of what Christ accomplishes: He institutes the Eucharist. He establishes the priesthood. He offers Himself as sacrifice. He enters death willingly. He opens the gates of Heaven. No prophet ever did this. No king ever did this. Only Christ.

THE SHOCKING TRUTH ABOUT HOLY WEEK

Here is what many miss: The most "holy" week... is also the most violent week. Betrayal, Torture, Mockery Crucifixion. How can that be "holy"? Because holiness is not the absence of suffering. It is the presence of God... even in suffering. And in this week, God is not distant from pain. He enters it completely.

THIS WEEK EXPOSES THE HUMAN HEART

Holy Week reveals two things at once: 1. The depth of God's love 2. The depth of human sin

People who shouted "Hosanna" now reject Him. A chosen Apostle betrays Him, A close friend denies Him. Leaders condemn Him The crowd prefers a criminal. This week is holy...Because it shows the truth about God

and the truth about us

WHY THE CHURCH SLOWS EVERYTHING DOWN

Notice something: The Church does not rush this week. Long readings, deep silence, extended liturgies. Why? Because you

POR QUÉ SE LLAMA «SEMANA SANTA»... Y NO SIMPLEMENTE «LA ÚLTIMA SEMANA DE JESÚS»

Muchas personas dicen: «Es la semana anterior a la Pascua». Pero la Iglesia no la llama así. Ella la llama:

SEMANA SANTA

Esa palabra no es un adorno. Es un juicio sobre toda la semana. Porque en estos días sucede algo que nunca antes había ocurrido...y que nunca volverá a ocurrir.

«SANTO» NO SIGNIFICA TRANQUILO... SIGNIFICA APARTADO PARA DIOS

En las Escrituras, «santo» no significa pacífico ni apacible.

Significa: Apartado, Consagrado, Perteneciente enteramente a Dios, Así que, cuando la Iglesia dice «Semana Santa», está diciendo: «Estos días no pertenecen a la historia ordinaria». «Estos días pertenecen completamente a la acción salvadora de Dios». Esta no es solo una semana que se recuerda. Es una semana que redefine la realidad misma.

ESTA ES LA SEMANA EN LA QUE TODO CAMBIA

Observa atentamente lo que sucede: Un Rey entra... y es rechazado Un discípulo come... y traiciona El Pan se convierte en Carne... por primera vez Dios es arrestado... por su propia creación La inocencia es condenada... por los culpables. El Creador es clavado... en su propia creación .La Muerte se encuentra con la Vida... y pierde. Este no es un tiempo normal. Este es un tiempo santo

LA SANTIDAD PROVIENE DE LO QUE CRISTO HACE

Esta semana es santa, no por las acciones humanas...sino por lo que Cristo realiza: Él instituye la Eucaristía

Él establece el sacerdocio. Él se ofrece a sí mismo como sacrificio. Él entra voluntariamente en la muerte.

Él abre las puertas del Cielo. Ningún profeta hizo jamás esto. Ningún rey hizo jamás esto. Solo Cristo.

LA VERDAD IMPACTANTE SOBRE LA SEMANA SANTA

Esto es lo que muchos pasan por alto: La semana más «santa»... es también la semana más violenta.

Traición, Tortura, Burla, Crucifixión. ¿Cómo puede ser eso «santo»? Porque la santidad no es la ausencia de sufrimiento. Es la presencia de Dios... incluso en medio del sufrimiento. Y en esta semana, Dios no se mantiene distante del dolor. Él entra en él por completo.

ESTA SEMANA DESNUDA EL CORAZÓN HUMANO

La Semana Santa revela dos cosas a la vez: 1. La profundidad del amor de Dios 2. La profundidad del pecado humano. Personas que gritaban «¡Hosanna!» ahora lo rechazan, Un apóstol elegido lo traiciona, Un amigo cercano lo niega, Los líderes lo condenan, La multitud prefiere a un criminal, Esta semana es santa...Porque muestra la verdad sobre Dios y la verdad sobre nosotros.

POR QUÉ LA IGLESIA LO DESACELERA TODO

Observa algo: La Iglesia no se apresura en esta semana. Lecturas extensas .Silencio profundo. Liturgias prolongadas
